2023 BUDGET PLANNING

The Newfolden budget committee began meeting on August 1st at 5:30 PM. The budget process begins with the examination of the current year's receipts and expenditures and how they compare to the budget predictions approved for 2022. The first order of business is the evaluation of the General and Fire Funds and how the needs of these funds may impact the local property tax levy set in September of each year. After this is accomplished, the budget committee will evaluate, compare, and contrast the current year's activities with the future needs of the water, electric, and sewer enterprise funds.

Some of the current year's activities include the procurement of a Fire Pumper Truck in partnership with area Townships, north-side signage, floodplain prevention project, and multiple electric enhancements and line upgrades. Some budget goals include sidewalk and street maintenance, housing and green space development. Be assured that the City Council strives to incorporate future planning goals for growth and quality of life with the ongoing and ever-present objective of minimizing property taxes, utility rates, and service fees. 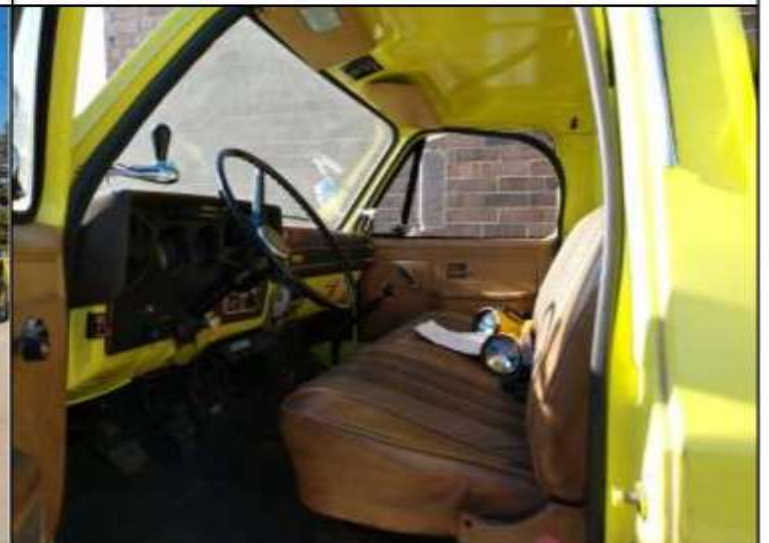
