

ORDINANCE NO. 22  
AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE TRAFFIC IN THE CITY OF NEWFOLDEN.

The City Council of the City of Newfolden ordains as follows:

SECTION 1 - DEFINITIONS - Unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the definitions shall be used in the context as in Minnesota, Statutes, Chapter 169.

SECTION 2 - Minnesota Statute 169 is hereby adopted by reference and made a part of the Ordinance of the City of Newfolden, and shall govern traffic except as hereinafter expanded or modified.

SECTION 3 - SQUEALING TIRES, GRINDING GEARS AND BACKFIRING - No person shall operate a vehicle on a public highway, street, parking lot, alley or other public property in such manner as to cause the tires to squeal, the gears to grind or the motor to backfire, except when an emergency creates a necessity for "such operation.

SECTION 4 - ERRATIC DRIVING - No person shall drive a vehicle on a public highway, street, parking lot, alley or other public property at erratic or irregular and changing speed so as to create a hazard to himself or other persons or property or so to interfere with other traffic in the area.

SECTION 5 - PARKING - No person shall park an automobile on the City streets of Newfolden, in the center of the street. All such parking is hereby prohibited. The Council may designate certain areas as angle parking or parallel parking, by resolution. Such parking shall take effect upon the passing of the resolution by the City Council. The Council may further require posting signs in the parking zones.

SECTION 6 - It shall be unlawful for any person driving a motor vehicle make a U-turn at places other than at intersections. Any U-turn shall be made by clearly stopping at each quadrant, getting a clear view of the traffic before proceeding to the next quadrant of the street, thereby repeating the procedure until a full U-turn has been made.

SECTION 7 - This Ordinance shall not apply to driving on a licensed racetrack with the permission and under the auspices and direction of the license.

SECTION 8 - Any person guilty of a violation of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

SECTION 9 - This ordinance may be amended by resolution of the City Council.

SECTION 10 - This ordinance becomes effective upon its passage and publication.
