

Board of Appeal & Equalization is April 15, 2024

The Board of Appeal and Equalization of the City of Newfolden shall meet on Monday, April 15, 2024 at 6:00PM at the Newfolden Community Center. If you believe the value or classification of your property is incorrect, please contact your assessor's office to discuss your concerns. If you disagree with the valuation or classification after discussing it with your assessor, you may appear before the local board of appeal and equalization. The board will review your assessments and may make corrections as needed. Generally, you must appeal to the local board before appealing to the Marshall County Board of Appeal and Equalization.

The City of Newfolden will provide a roll-out dumpster to collect all those items you are unable to dispose of in your weekly garbage. Items such as furniture, light construction materials, appliances that **<u>DO NOT</u>** contain Freon, and much more can be placed into this dumpster. It will be located behind the Newfolden Community Center. Please do not discard hazardous waste in this dumpster; a list of items considered hazardous waste is included for your reference.

Hazardous waste pick up is available May 30th, from 9:00 to 11:00 am.
