## Board of Appeal & Equalization is April 14, 2025

The Board of Appeal and Equalization of the City of Newfolden shall meet on Monday, April 14, 2025 at 6:00PM at the Newfolden Community Center. If you believe the value or classification of your property is incorrect, please contact your assessor's office to discuss your concerns. If you disagree with the valuation or classification after discussing it with your assessor, you may appear before the local board of appeal and equalization. The board will review your assessments and may make corrections as needed. Generally, you must appeal to the local board before appealing to the Marshall County Board of Appeal and Equalization.
