

Ordinance No. _____

The City Council of the City of Newfolden ordains as follows:

Subd. 1. It shall be unlawful for any individual under the age of 17 years to be in or upon the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, parks, playgrounds or other public grounds, public places, public buildings, places of amusement, places of entertainment, places where food or drink are served, vacant lots or other areas unsupervised by the individual's parents, guardians or other adult person having the care and custody of the individual during the hours set forth in Subdivision 5.

Subd. 2. It shall be unlawful for the parent, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of an individual under the age of 17 years to knowingly, or with reason to know, permit such individual to be in or upon the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, parks, playgrounds or other public grounds, public places, public buildings, places of amusement, places of entertainment, places where food or drink are served, vacant lots or other areas unsupervised by the individuals parents, guardians or other adult person having the care and custody of the individual during the hours set forth in Subdivision 5.

Subd. 3. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation operating or in charge of any place of amusement, place of entertainment, place where food or drink are sold or other business place to knowingly, or with reason to know, to permit any individual under the age of 17 years to enter or remain in such place during the hours set forth in Subdivision 5.

Subd. 4. Upon request of the superintendent of the

schools of the Marshall County Central school district, the Mayor may designate certain nights during the school year as "School Nights", during which said school shall be engaged in athletic, musical, dramatic or social activities for the benefit or entertainment of its students, and the provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to any such school function on a designated school night during the hours as designated by said superintendent of public schools.

Subd. 5. Hours herein shall mean as follows:

For all individuals under the age of 17, hours shall mean 11:00 o'clock p.m. until 6:00 o'clock a.m. of the following day.

Subd. 6. The provision of this ordinance shall not apply to any individual under 17 years of age accompanied by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the individual.

Subd. 7. Violation of this ordinance shall be a petty misdemeanor.
