Yard Debris and Unused Vehicle Clean-up

Several complaints have been made by concerned citizens regarding excessive debris on property within the city limits. A violation of the Nuisance Ordinance is defined by accumulations in the open, of discarded or disused machinery, household appliances, automobile bodies, or other material, in a manner conducive to the harboring of rates, mice, snakes, or vermin, or to fire, health and safety hazards from such accumulation or from the rank growth of vegetation among the items so accumulated. The maintenance of conditions which unreasonably annoys, injures, or endangers the safety, health, moral, comfort, or repose of any considerable number of members of the public is considered a misdemeanor.

Letters may be sent to property owners considered in violation. The City Council is asking households to consider this concern and make efforts to clean up such debris.

HAZARDOUS WASTE PICK-UP IS MAY 31ST

Marshall County Solid Waste will be hosting a hazardous waste pick-up during Spring Clean-Up week. Hazardous Waste pick-up will be facilitated on Tuesday, May 31st from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM behind the Community Center.

This opportunity allows for the pick-up of those items not allowed in the Les's Sanitation dumpsters (which will remain available throughout spring clean-up week). Please note that some items include a fee for disposal.
